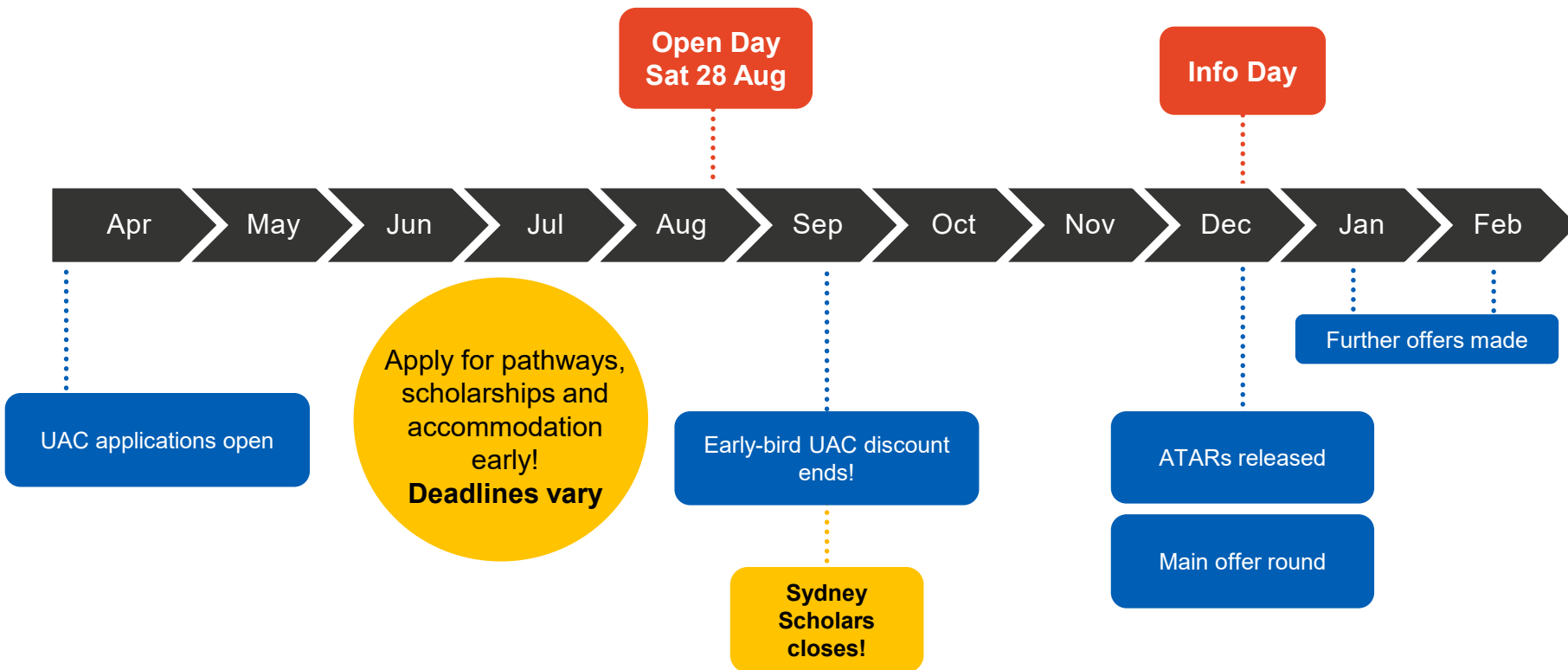
Admission pathways
